Safe Set Down Area

Our Safe Set Down Area has been working very well to ensure the safety of our school community. At home time, we continue to ask parents to queue up in their cars to use the set down area to drop or collect children. The front door of the school is the drop off/collection point, children will not be on the roadside. Children walking or cycling home may use the pedestrian gates.

We kindly ask parents not to park at either side of the entrance or exit gate or on the opposite side of the road as this will cause an obstruction and disrupt the flow of traffic.

We appreciate your co-operation in continuing to ensure safe drop-off & collection practices. The safety of your child/children is of utmost importance to us all.

First Days Back at School:

Tues 29th & Wed 30th - Parents of Junior Infant children may park on the tarmac to the right side of the school. Senior Infants to 6th Class go straight to their classrooms from 9.10am & supervised by their class teacher.

Tues 29th – Junior Infant Parents accompany children into their classroom.

Wed 30th – Junior Parents accompany children to the front door. We kindly ask Junior Infant parents not to park in the Set Down Area on these two mornings when they accompany their children as this will cause an obstruction for other parents.

Thurs 31st – Morning drop off resumes as normal & all pupils congregate on Tarmac from 9.10am
